ORDER RE: ORAL ARGUMENT

This matter is currently before the Court on the parties' Cross-Motions for Summary Judgment, although neither summary judgment motion is yet ripe. The Court issues this Order to address oral argument on the summary judgment motions, which is currently scheduled for April 15, 2020 at 2:00 P.M. In light of recent developments and concerns surrounding COVID-19, as outlined in both the 3/19/202 Special Order No. 8131 of the Chief Justice of the Alaska Supreme Court, and the 3/23/2020 Presiding Judge Statewide Administrative Order Governing Relaxation and Suspension of Various Court Rules Based on the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Court does not anticipate being able to hold oral argument as currently scheduled. The Court requests that on or before the simultaneous deadline of March 31, 2020, the parties each file a short pleading notifying the Court of their respective positions on the following: 1) whether oral argument is required in order to decide the cross-motions; 2) if oral argument is

required from a party's perspective, why that is the case and what legal questions or issues will require further explanation and/or development in oral argument; and 3) whether, assuming the Court holds oral argument, the parties have additional suggestions or requests about the scheduling of oral argument (recognizing the above-cited Orders) and the manner in which the argument occurs (*i.e.*, whether the oral argument should proceed telephonically or by other means of remote participation).






