the separation of powers doctrine embodied in the Alaska Constitution.

- 2. Governor Dunleavy's veto of funds from the appellate courts' fiscal year 2021 budget is void, and the vetoed sum of \$334,700 shall be restored.
- 3. Defendants are directed to refund the amount of \$344,700 to the appellate courts' fiscal year 2021 budget within 30 days of this Order.
