
Kevin Meyer, Lieutenant Governor of the State of Alaska, the Alaska Division of Elections, and Gail Fenumiai, Director of the Alaska Division of Elections (Petitioners) filed a petition for review of the superior court's October 5, 2020 order granting a motion for preliminary injunction filed by Arctic Village Council, League of Women Voters of Alaska, Elizabeth L. Jones, and Barbara Clark (Respondents). We held oral argument on an expedited basis. Based on the record and the parties' written and oral arguments, we conclude that the superior court did not abuse its discretion by granting the preliminary injunction.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Petitioners' petition for review is **GRANTED** and the superior court's order is **AFFIRMED**. A full opinion will follow.
